

How to prepare your file for printing?

Image file guidelines

Resolution min. 150 dpi

Format .jpg, .png, .tiff with LZW compression

Color palette

- **Pigment printing:** CMYK, profile U.S. Web Coated (SWOP) v2
- **Sublimation printing:** CMYK, profile U.S. Web Coated (SWOP) v2
- **Acid printing:** RGB, profile sRGB
- **Reactive printing:** RGB, profile Adobe RGB

For pigment printing, please ensure the total ink coverage (CMYK) does not exceed 230%, to avoid over-inking during printing.

Size max. 25 MB

Printing panels

If you want your graphic panel printed in specific dimensions, your file must contain the artwork designed exactly at the size you want it printed. Remember to take into account the width of the fabric you choose — different fabrics and knits have different roll widths. To ensure accurate printing, prepare your file at a **1:1 scale**. **Resolution, format, color profile, and file size should follow the same guidelines as above.**
