

How to upload a large file?

Image file guidelines

Thank you for choosing CottonBee as your fabric printing company. To make the process of placing orders a bit easier for you, we've made guidelines for preparing your image files.

Name	include the size of the image, type of fabric and the overall length in centimeters, e.g. "filename_25x25cm_satin_500cm.jpg"
Format	.jpg, .png, .tiff with LZW compression
Scale	we print in 1:1 scale, so make sure your file is saved in a proper size
Resolution	min. 150 dpi
Color palette	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pigment printing: CMYK, profile U.S. Web Coated (SWOP) v2 • Sublimation printing: CMYK, profile U.S. Web Coated (SWOP) v2 • Acid printing: RGB, profile sRGB • Reactive printing: RGB, profile Adobe RGB <p>For pigment printing, please ensure the total ink coverage (CMYK) does not exceed 230%, to avoid over-inking during printing.</p>
Length	The file must be at least 1 meter in length, but not longer than 5 meters. Always round up the file length to a number divisible by 10. For a 1,47 m file, round up the length and save it as a 1,5 m file.
Size	max. 1,5 GB

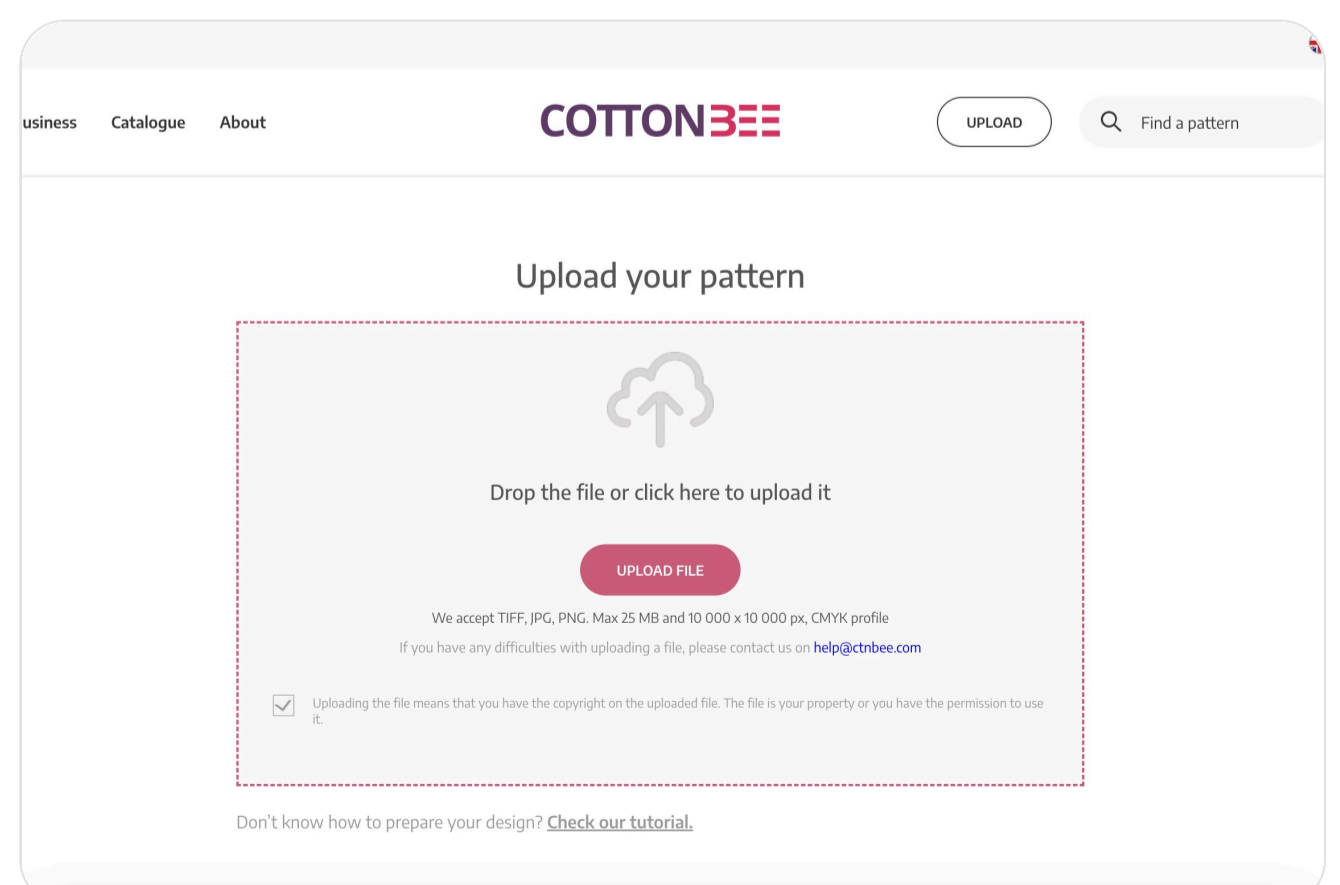

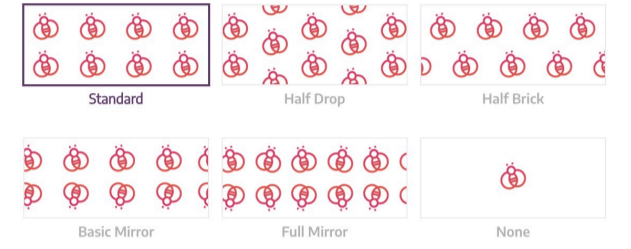
Skip the file size setting and choose the type of repeat for the final file.

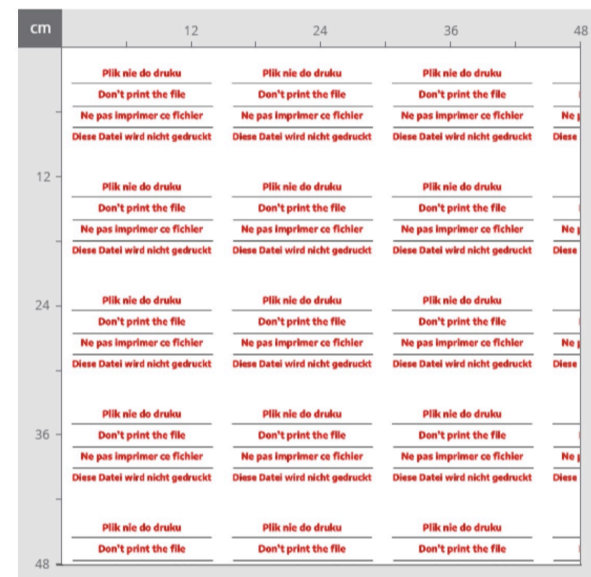

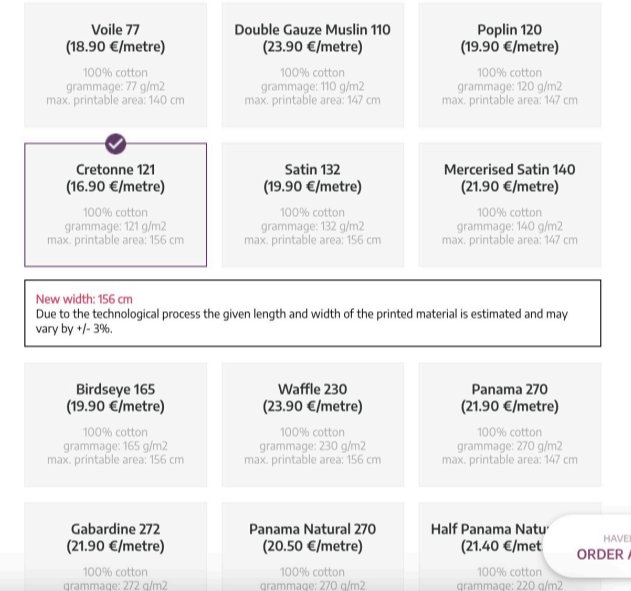

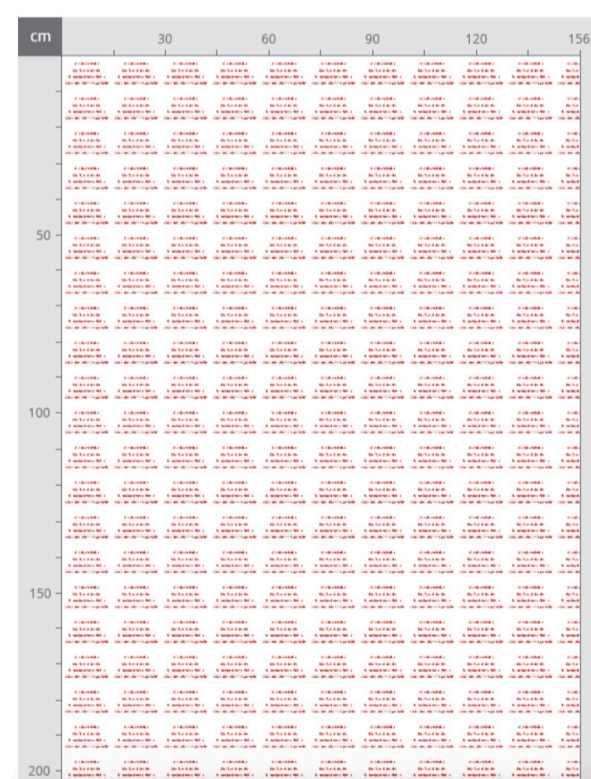

Choose the fabric size (sample/coupon/meter) and quantity.

Remember, if you select "meter," you enter the number of meters, not the number of repeats. This means that if your file is 147x50 cm and you want 6 repeats, enter 3m.

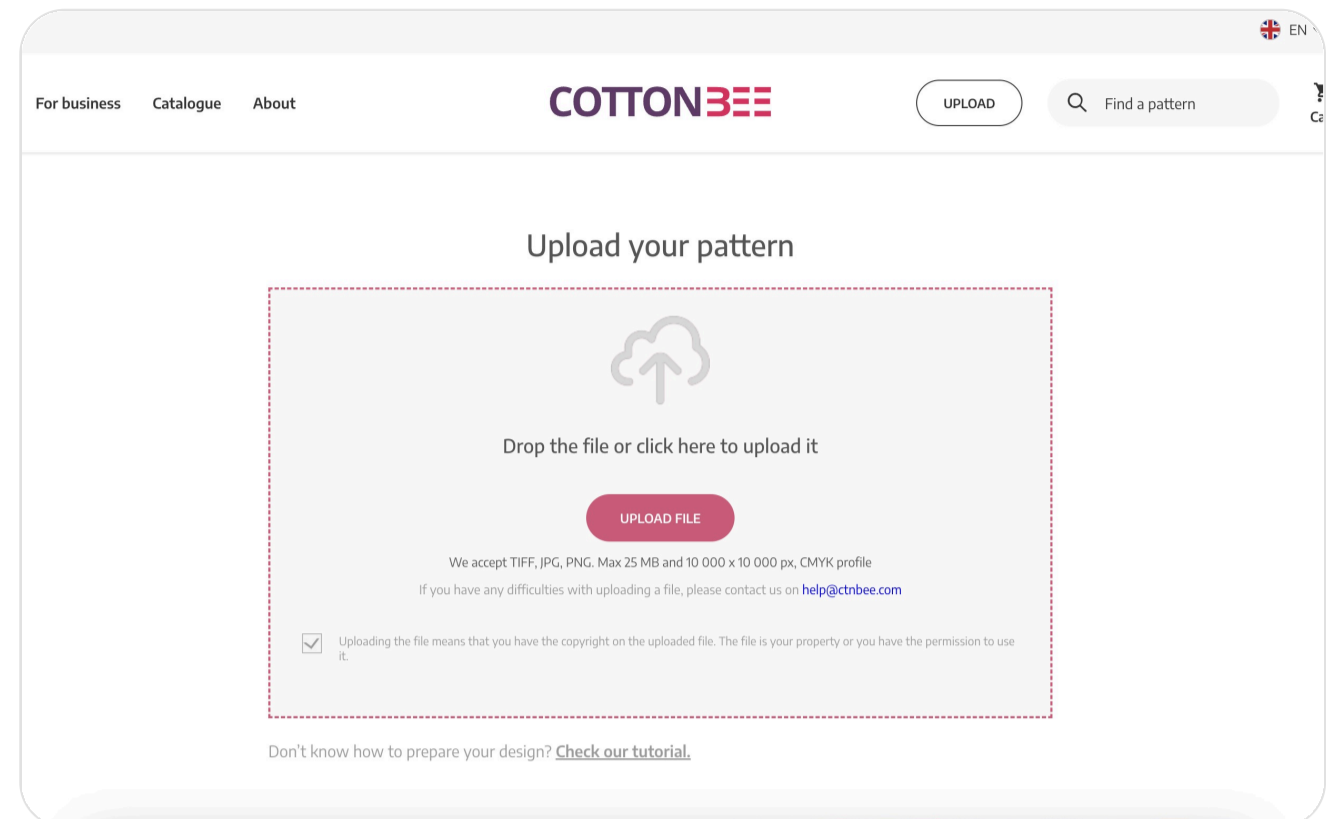
